2. Concert bands are getting ready for the spring concert at end of May.
3. Indoor Percussion in the middle of Virtual and in person circuit
  - a. Performance at Pace (2/27) and one at Tate (3/27)
  - b. Virtual recording session last Thursday (3/4) – again this Thursday (3/11) at 7:30
  - c. Last performance for John as it is his final year.
    - i. Performance is a celebration of him and his favorite shows
  - d. John - Do something for him for his retirement?
    - i. Maybe a roast?
    - ii. Sign about percussion room for John – name the room after him – present sign at the award ceremony

4. Guard supposed to do solo ensemble this past Monday (3/8) but they weren't read .
