Name Change Policy

Name Changes are allowed only at the discretion of Carnival Cruise Lines. At 120 days prior to sailing (November 19), a \$75.00 Fee will be applicable for each and every change involving names. Remember, name changes must be male to male or female to female.

At least one original person must stay in the cabin or it will be considered a complete cabin cancellation.

Other Things to Know:

- ***Travel Documents You will need proof of US Citizenship. A *Passport* is highly recommended; however you may use a *state-issued birth certificate along with a government-issued photo ID* since it is a closed-loop tour...meaning that you depart and arrive back in the same port. A passport would allow you to fly home from Mexico in the event of an emergency. Current turnaround time on passports is 10 to 13 weeks. If you choose to use a *birth certificate*, please make sure that you have the state-issued birth certificate...not the one with your handprints and footprints on them! Passports will cost you \$130 and are available at the Santa Rosa County Clerk of Courts Office. You can have your passport photos made at CVS Pharmacy in Milton. More info can be found at https://santarosaclerk.com/other-services/passports/
- Four students per cabin AND Two adults per cabin. Each of you should have your own bed. The cabins are usually set-up like having two bunk beds with the top beds being lowered down from the wall. Participants should not have to share beds...unless they are a married couple and request that the beds be turned into a King bed.
- The cabins are **interior rooms**...meaning that they have no windows! But the cabin is usually only a place for resting, showering, and sleeping. There are tons of activities to do outside of the cabin...or just simply find a lounge chair and enjoy the sun and ocean.
- Money on Board the ship and in port The cruise uses what is called a cashless system, meaning that no cash or debit/credit cards are accepted. Passengers will load their "sign-and-sail" accounts once you board the ship on day 1 and use your that on board. More on this at a later meeting. Both ports accept credit/debit cards as well as American cash. Remember to inform your band that you will be in Mexico March 13-23 to avoid automatic fraud holds.
- > If you book outside of the group, remember that you are NOT part of the Band Trip. Our activities don't include you or your family. Remember that you'll need to provide your own transportation and pay for parking at the port, arrange your own excursions, and take care of your own check-in and debarkation.
- > We will have some "cruise training" meetings that will take place prior to our departure. We will cover items such as Mexican culture, insight into packing, proper dining etiquette, cruise hints & tips, etc. Adults attending the trip are encouraged to attend these meetings.
- > One of the dinners on the cruise will be a **Formal Night**. **Dressy attire** will be required of all participants. Some of the young ladies wear prom dresses. Any dressy Sunday dress, or semiformal or formal gown. For gentlemen, a suit and tie, slacks, sport coat and tie. A tuxedo is also appropriate but is not required. I've discovered that our students like to dress up for this event in the past! It is okay to dress up multiple nights.
- > Of all the trips that we take every four years with the band, this is **one of the most memorable trips** for our students! For the majority of our students, this is their first cruise as well as their first time being out of the country. The education that they receive from this experience is priceless!
