UNIFORM CLEANING PROCEDURE

Jacket, Sash, and Gauntlets are school-owned and MUST be returned, cleaned. Some students may have been issued other uniform parts which we have documented. If this applies to you, these parts MUST be returned clean as well with the exception of gloves.

- Pants, Jackets, and Gloves are machine washable.
- Use COLD water on the GENTLE CYCLE and low heat in the dryer.
- JACKET WASHING INSTRUCTIONS.
 - Detach the sash from the jacket. (DO NOT WASH THE SASH!!)
 - $\circ~$ Flip the shoulder guards in towards the ribbon strip at the top of the jacket
 - $\circ~$ Turn the jacket inside out and wash in COLD water using the GENTLE CYCLE
 - Place in drier using low heat
 - Do not press or iron the jacket as it will leave marks on the material
- DO NOT WASH THE SASH!
 - IF THE SASH SHOULD BECOME DAMP, ALLOW IT TO DRY IN A WELL VENTILATED AREA.
- GAUNTLETS and HELMETS should be wiped down with water and soap only.
 - Allow to dry in a well ventilated area
 - Do not keep gauntlets in the helmet box as this could cause mold to form on the gauntlets and the paint to bubble on the helmet
- THE PLUME SHOULD NOT BE WASHED.
 - IF RAIN SHOULD MAKE CONTACT WITH IT, ALLOW TO DRY IN A WELL-VENTILATED AREA.
- Wipe SHOES with a damp cloth to clean
